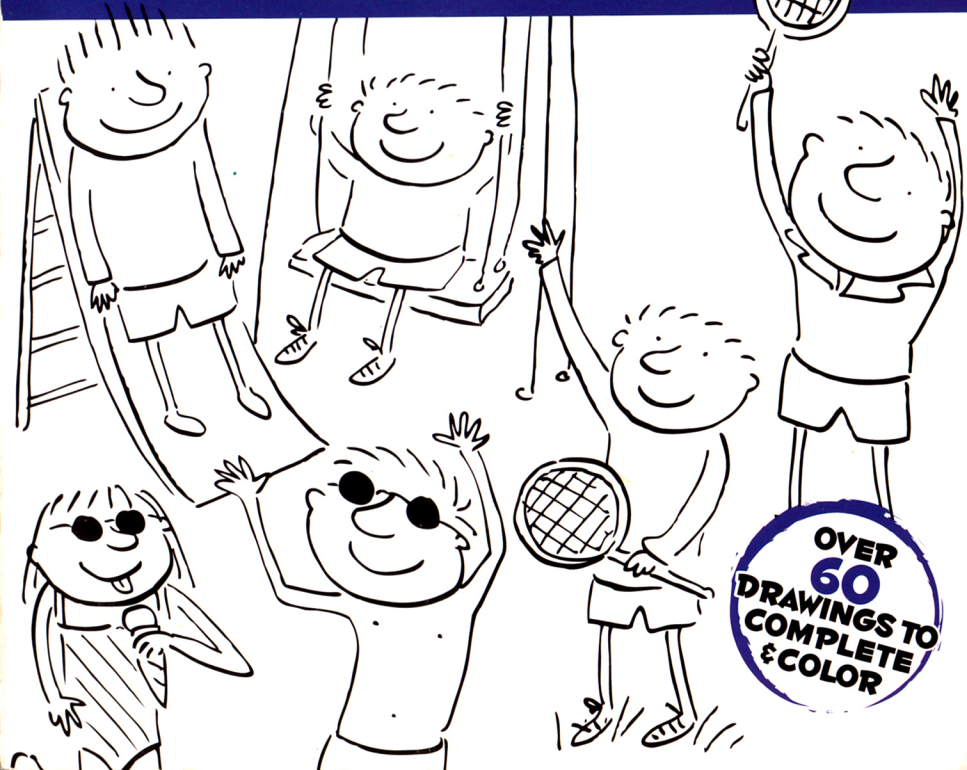

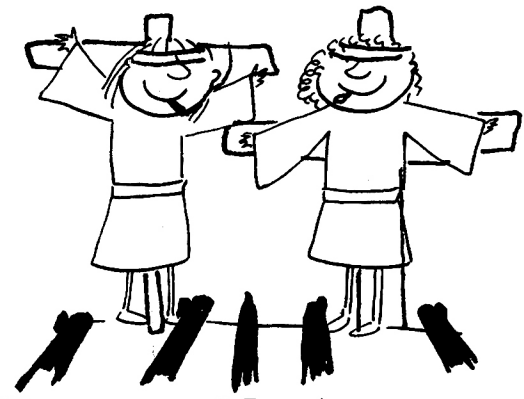

You were given a partial drawing, and some text, inviting you to finish the drawing.

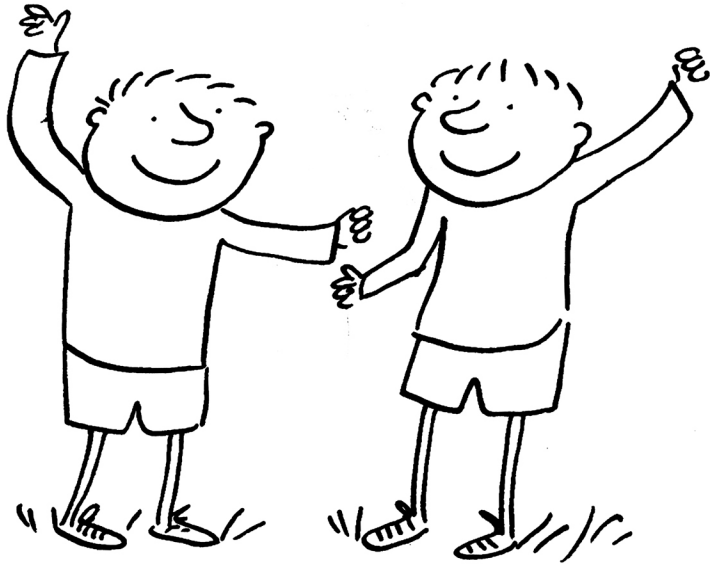
As I flipped through it, all I could imagine was horrible, terrible things. Gruesome, disgusting or naughty things.
